Announcement of the State Financial and Fiscal Policy Committee Regarding the Determination of Compensation Rates for Expenses or Loss of Revenue Incurred by Government Agencies in Carrying Out Activities, Measures, or Projects as Specified in Section 28 of the Act of B.E. 2565

Pursuant to the authority granted under Section 11(6) in conjunction with Section 28, Paragraph 3, of the on State Financial and Fiscal Discipline B.E. 2561 and the resolution of the State Financial and Fiscal Policy Committee at its meeting No. 1/2565 held on August 15, B.E. 2565, hereby issues the following proclamation

Section 1: The Proclamation of the State Financial and Fiscal Policy Committee regarding the determination of rates for compensation for expenses or revenue losses incurred by government agencies in carrying out activities, measures, or projects as specified in Section 28 (Amendment No. 2) B.E. 2564 is hereby repealed

Section 2: The total outstanding balance of obligations for which the State must compensate for expenses or revenue losses incurred in carrying out activities, measures, or projects as specified in Section 28 shall not exceed thirty-two percent of the annual expenditure budget This shall take effect as of October 3, B.E. 2565
