

PDMO Screening Criteria for Programs/Projects under the Energy-Crisis Borrowing Decree, B.E. 2569 (2026)

Criteria for Reviewing and Screening Work Plans/Projects Under the Royal Decree Authorizing the Ministry of Finance to Borrow Funds to Address the Impacts of the Energy Crisis and Facilitate the Nation's Energy Transition, B.E. 2569

- 1) The project must be consistent with Section 11 of the Ministry of Finance Regulation on the Implementation of Work Plans or Projects under the Act Authorizing the Ministry of Finance to Borrow Funds to Address the Impacts of the Energy Crisis and Facilitate the Nation's Energy Transition, B.E. 2569, namely
- (1) The project's objectives must align with the work plans or projects specified in the schedule attached to the Royal Decree Authorizing the Ministry of Finance to Borrow Funds to Address the Impacts of the Energy Crisis and Facilitate the Nation's Energy Transition, B.E. 2569 (the Royal Decree)
- (2) Projects for which there is an urgent need to make expenditures or incur binding obligations immediately, but for which no budget allocation has been made or for which a budget allocation has been made but is insufficient
- (3) Projects that are ready and capable of being implemented immediately upon receiving approval from the Cabinet
- (4) Projects that are cost-effective to implement and generate economic or social benefits in accordance with the objectives specified in the schedule attached to the Royal Decree
- 2) Projects that adhere to the principles of good governance, taking into account efficiency, effectiveness, the needs of the public and communities, transparency, and accountability, with the project-owning agency required to report the results of its operations to the public on an ongoing basis
- 3) Projects that can be completed by September 30, 2570, and for which all disbursements are finalized by December 31, 2570
- 4) Projects that promote or support the enhancement of the competitiveness of Thai businesses
- 5) Projects that do not involve the hiring of consultants for research studies, study tours, or overseas travel
